AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING

REGISTERED, UNREGISTERED & PUREBRED BREEDING FEMALES

1. Judging to begin at the conclusion of the Market Swine classes on Wednesday, May 23.
2. Junior Breeding Swine will not be released prior to 8:00 p.m. Monday, May 28 without special written permission from Fair Management. Exhibitors that remove animals prior to that time will forfeit premium checks and may be prevented from showing in future Silver Dollar Fairs. Animals entered in this department must remain on display the duration of the fair.
3. Open to residents of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Plumas, Sutter, Tehama, and Yuba Counties.
4. Breeding Livestock projects must be owned solely by & under the exhibitor’s care and management for at least 30 days prior to the opening day of the Fair as per CDFA State Rule Section VII, Rule # 26.
5. Registered, unregistered & purebred gilts/sows will show in the same division.
6. All breeding swine must have an ear notch, tattoo, or ear tag and ID number, birthdate and sire must be recorded on entry form. DRAW EAR NOTCHES ON ENTRY FORM. DO NOT use numbers to identify notches.
7. Sows, junior yearlings and older must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry.
8. Junior Exhibitors are required to fit and groom their own animals. See Local Rule # 50
9. State and Local Rules apply.
