If the songs are covers, please list the artist whom originally performed the song; if original songs, please provide description of type of music and full lyrics for at least three (3) of the original songs to be performed.

Again, please submit your Community Entertainment Application by March 15th so we can include you and/or your group in our publicity effort. We will try to accommodate all of your performance time preferences, although we will honor all applications as received. You will receive notification of your participation in the fair by April 1st.

- Please attach a list of all participant's names, and support staff names and function in relation to this performance. This list will be used to determine the number of complimentary admission tickets to issue for performers, staff, and chaperone(s). Tickets will not be issued until list is submitted. Each performer/staff/chaperone **must** have ticket for admittance to the Fair.

- A Community Showcase Entertainment Agreement will be sent to you by April 1st confirming the stage, date and time assigned for you and/or your group to perform. Only performances specified and outlines in the Showcase Entertainment Agreement will be permitted. If you require alternative or additional space, arrangements must be made with our Grounds Entertainment Coordinator prior to your arrival at the fair. You may be required to provide additional insurance for your group depending on the type of activity your group will perform and the alternative location assigned.

- Once a performance time is set up, there can be no last minute changes or substitutions. *Performance times include set up and tear down, as well as actual performance.* Due to the close scheduling of performances you will not be allowed to perform past your scheduled performance time. Please be considerate of your fellow entertainers. Please notify the fair immediately in the event of a cancellation.

- Special arrangements must be made in advance of arrival for loading/unloading of equipment; the Fairgrounds will provide microphones, microphone stands, sound systems, CD players, lighting and performance stage – no piano available.

- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the stage or in staging area, no solicitation of money, no sales of any type, no distribution of information/flyers through the audience, no inviting audience onto stage, no throwing anything from stage, no destruction of equipment (instruments included) on stage, no sharing of time slot with other groups unless authorized by management prior to fair.

- It is your responsibility to ensure that all participants are informed of these rules. This application must be completed, signed, dated and returned to the Fair by March 15th.
