1. Judging will start at the conclusion of Showmanship and Market Steer Classes on Thursday, May 24.
2. Livestock exhibitors must provide Proof of Insurance (3rd Party Liability) to exhibit livestock at the Silver Dollar Fair. See local rule #19.
3. Registration papers must be checked by 8:00 pm Wed., May 23.
4. Open to residents of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Plumas, Sutter, Tehama and Yuba Counties.
5. BEEF CATTLE: All females 24 (twenty four) months of age or older on the beginning day of the fair must: a) have a calf at side; OR b) show obvious signs of pregnancy; OR c) have a veterinarian's certificate of pregnancy.
6. Junior Exhibitors are required to fit and groom their own animals. See Local Rule # 47.
7. All animals MUST be halter broke and manageable as determined by Fair Management.
8. All breeds judged together.
9. GROUPS - Animals used in groups must be owned by one exhibitor and ENTERED as individuals. All animals entered in groups must be of one breed.

COW/CALF- A cow and her natural calf. Embryo transfer calves are not eligible. Cows must be registered and have a nursing calf at side. Calf may be shown in its appropriate age class, provided it meets all requirements for show. Calves must be eligible for registration with that breed association and papers must be at least pending if competing only in the cow/calf class.

10. State and Local Rules apply

ADDITIONAL RULES APPLYING TO DIVISION B - UNREGISTERED BEEF CATTLE

11. Only unregistered purebred or grade beef cattle may be entered. Animals which have been registered by a purebred beef organization cannot be entered in this division.
12. A permanent eartag, tattoo number or brand is required and must be on entry form.
13. Exhibitor limited to 2 entries per class.

- 1. Open to residents, students, and members of recognized Butte County clubs or chapters.
- 2. All prospect steers must be owned by exhibitor for a minimum of 30 days prior to the opening day of the fair.
- 3. Steers must have an eartag for identification. Eartag number must be on entry form, be on the steer upon arrival and remain on the steer through the Fair.
- 4. Steers must be weighed in between 5:30 and 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 22. Weights will only be used to divide the classes. There are no weight restrictions in this division.
- 5. Steers ENTERED in Junior Livestock Market classes and NOT making the minimum weight requirements may be entered in the Prospect Steer class upon exhibitor's request. The exhibitor must request this change at the Livestock Office immediately after weigh-in and no later than 9:00 p.m.
- 6. PROSPECT STEERS ARE **NOT** ELIGIBLE TO SELL AT THE JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION.
- 7. Exhibitors may participate in showmanship and be eligible for Round Robin.
- 8. Judging will follow the Market Steer Classes.
- 9. Junior Exhibitors are required to fit and groom their own animals. See Local Rule #47.
- 10. Animals will not be released until 8 p.m., Monday, May 28.
- 11. State and Local Rules apply.
