

**DEPARTMENT 34
FFA AND 4-H MARKET GOATS**

1. Entries close when limits are reached, no later than March 26 at 5:00 p.m. Exhibitor limited to one market animal entry.
2. Livestock exhibitors must provide Proof of Insurance (3rd Party Liability) to exhibit livestock at the Silver Dollar Fair. See local rule #19.
3. Exhibits must be in place Tuesday, May 22 at 7:00 p.m.
4. Market Goats will be weighed between 5:30 - 7:30 p.m. Tues., May 22. After weighing, market goats may be divided into weight lots within the pound limitations as desired by the management for convenience in judging.
5. Goats not meeting the weight requirements and not participating in Showmanship must be removed from the grounds immediately after weigh-in. Animals sifted for health reasons must be removed immediately.
6. Judging to start at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, May 23. MARKET GOATS SIFTED BY THE JUDGE MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS BY 9:00 a.m., THURSDAY, MAY 24 AND MUST HAVE A RELEASE SIGNED BY LIVESTOCK MANAGEMENT.
7. Open to residents, students, or members of Butte County recognized clubs or chapters.
8. Junior Exhibitors are required to fit & groom their own animals. See Local Rule #47.
9. Market goats are wethers and does only. No bucks allowed.
10. State and Local Rules apply.
11. Market goats must be owned by the exhibitor for 60 consecutive days prior to opening day of the fair. See Local Rule #42 for photo requirement.
12. The Junior Livestock Auction is a TERMINAL SALE. No Live Animal Pickup - No Exceptions. No registration papers will be provided by the seller. Buyer of animals through the Auction shall not negotiate resale of animals during the sale. Transfer of animals from one buyer to another will not be permitted through the sale office.
13. All goats must be dehorned. All scurs and regrowth must not exceed one inch in length and be blunt ended.
14. All market goats will be mouthed at the scale. Market goats must have milk teeth in normal positions and no permanent teeth showing at weigh-in. Any goat having lost any of its milk teeth will be disqualified. A veterinarian will be present at weigh-in to conduct health checks. Any animal exhibiting a contagious disease will be sent home.
15. IMPORTANT: SCRAPIES IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: SEE STATE RULES, SECTION X "SHEEP AND GOAT HEALTH RULES, #1-9.

MARKET GOAT (CHEVON) SCORECARD

GROUP 1: MARKET READY: USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08-.12 most desirable, .13-.22 back fat acceptable with greater conformation & cutability.....PURPLE RIBBON

GROUP 2: MARKET READY: USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08-.12 most desirable, .13-.22 back fat acceptable with average conformation & cutability.....BLUE RIBBON

GROUP 3: NOT MARKET READY: Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.08 or >.22; underfinished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability.....RED RIBBON

ONLY GROUPS 1 AND 2 ANIMALS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION

DIVISION C – JUNIOR MARKET GOATS OWNED/BRED BY EXHIBITOR

1. Animal must be entered as a Market Goat, meet weight requirements & qualify for Junior Livestock Auction to be eligible for this division.
2. Goat from Dam bred & owned by the exhibitor: Exhibitor must have owned Dam continuously since time of conception of market goat through May 24. Exhibitor must state on entry form market animal's date of birth & that the animal qualifies for the owned/bred by class.
