1. Open to residents of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Plumas, Sutter, Tehama, and Yuba counties.
2. Livestock exhibitors must provide Proof of Insurance (3rd Party Liability) to exhibit livestock at the Silver Dollar Fair. See local rule #19.
3. Judging for Junior Meat Goat classes to begin at the conclusion of Market Goat competition on Wednesday, May 23.
4. All registered, unregistered, purebred, and crossbred goats will be judged together.
5. Junior exhibitors are required to fit and groom their own animals. See Local Rule #47.
6. A permanent eartag or tattoo number is required.
7. No bucks permitted.
8. A veterinarian will be present on the grounds & may conduct health checks. Animals exhibiting signs of contagious disease will be sent home.
9. Goats shown in the meat goat show are not eligible to compete in the market goat show or sell at the Junior Livestock Auction.
10. State and Local Rules apply.
11. American System of Judging will be used.
12. IMPORTANT: SCRAPIES IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: SEE STATE RULES, SECTION X "SHEEP AND GOAT HEALTH RULES, #1-9.
